DARRELL HOLT CHALLENGE TEAMS' ROLL-OFFS
RULES, PARTICIPANT INFORMATION, and NOMINATION FORM

ELIGIBILITY

Nomination is open to all bowlers meeting eligibility criteria;

- 1) For both tournaments:
 - a. Be resident in the Zone for which the roll-off is being held
 - b. Have attained, or will attain, the age of 18 years on, or prior to, the first day of the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival in the current year
 - c. Have competed in at least eight (8) weeks of league competition;
 - i. bowling a minimum of twenty-four (24) games in a single league
 - ii. in a registered Centre within the Zone for which the trials are being held;
 - iii. within the current calendar year
- 2) For the **Restricted** tournament:
 - a. Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 184
 - b. Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 174
- 3) For the **Classic** tournament:
 - a. Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 199
 - b. Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 189

AVERAGE

The average to be used for the roll-off must be over a minimum of twenty-four (24) games, and must be the highest of the following when measured at the **end of the previous year**;

- 1) Regular league average
- 2) Touring league average

HANDICAP

Handicap will be applicable to bowlers' scores when used towards the **Restricted** team, and shall be **100%** of the difference between the bowler's average and a threshold of **200**

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Smoking, and the Consumption of Alcohol, is prohibited whilst the Trials are in progress.

DISPUTES

Any disputes or complaints must be lodged with the Tournament Director within fifteen minutes of the alleged infringement.

BOWLING ATTIRE

All bowlers are required to wear a Shirt with a collar. Neat and tidy bowling attire, with no jeans or hats to be worn whilst competing, without the approval of the Tournament Director.
The Tournament Committee to decide on acceptable attire.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) All TBA Tournament Rules & Regulations will apply
- 2) Any matters not covered in the conditions will be decided by the Tournament Committee
- 3) No refunds will be paid
- 4) Participation in your State Championships will not be a requirement
- 5) If a Team Vacancy arises the spot will be filled by the next available bowler who participated in the roll-offs
- 6) Depending on the outcome of Fundraising Events throughout the year, individual bowlers will be required to pay all expenses remaining.
- 7) Full cost of Trials is to be paid before commencement of Day 1.

SCHEDULE

A briefing will occur before commencement of play on the first day

DAY 1, 7 GAMES KIRWAN BOWL DATE: Saturday 27th March.
CHECK-IN BY 11.30am for 12:00 Noon START

DAY 2, 7 GAMES KIRWAN BOWL DATE: Sunday 28th March
CHECK-IN BY 7.30am for 8.00am START

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SELECTION OF TEAMS

At the completion of the 14 games, the tournament committee will announce the teams for both the Restricted and Classic Challenges, based upon the following;

1) **DARRELL HOLT RESTRICTED CHALLENGE TEAM**

The top seven (7) male, and top seven (7) female bowlers based on total score with handicap will be declared the Darrell Holt Restricted Challenge Team for the current year

- a. In the event of a tie for the first or final position in either division, a one game playoff will be used to determine the first or final place
- b. Handicap shall be applied as normal to the playoff game

2) **DARRELL HOLT CLASSIC CHALLENGE TEAM**

The top three (3) male, and top three (3) female bowlers based on total scratch score only will be declared the Darrell Holt Classic Challenge Team for the current year

- a. In the event of a tie for the first or final position in either division, a one game playoff will be used to determine the first or final place
- b. **No** handicap will be applied to a playoff

REPRESENTATION at TROPHY EVENTS

The top qualifier in each team, of each male and female, will earn the right to represent the state at the relevant trophy event during the current years Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival

THE HOLT TENPIN BOWLING CARNIVAL

The 2010 Darrell Holt Challenge Teams will compete in the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival to be conducted at Altona Tenpin Bowling Complex, Victoria from 31st August to 11th September 2010.

All bowlers who were not successful in making the teams are welcomed to attend the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival to participate in the other events. Further information can be found at www.holtchallenge.org.au.

COSTS AND DEPOSITS

The following information is applicable to either team, and in the case where a bowler makes both teams the following should be applied for both teams (in effect, the amounts are double for bowlers in both teams), so that both teams may offset their preliminary costs

Costs for Challenge Teams include Accommodation, Travel, Meals, All Events Entries, Uniform, Dinner Tickets, the Tournament Registration Fee and Holt Membership Fee. The costs must be paid as per the following payment schedule;

1. \$100.00 deposit on or before 21st April 2010.
2. \$250.00 second part, on or before 21st May 2010.
3. \$250.00 third part, on or before 21st June 2010.
4. \$250.00 fourth part, on or before 21st July 2010.

Payments 2, 3 & 4 are required for all bowlers and team officials, irrespective of any fundraising that may have been participated in.

4. A final payment, on or before 20th August 2010
 - a. This payment will depend on fundraising
 - b. **If the payment of the full balance cannot be met by the due date, the person involved will be deemed ineligible to participate in the Holt Challenge for the current year**

NOMINATION FOR TEAM OFFICIALS

- Each team is limited to two team officials. This can be one coach and one manager, two managers or two coaches
- Any interested person may apply. No qualification is required
- Applicants are required to submit written application to: Coral Haworth
- Nominations close: 16th April 2010
