DARRELL HOLT CHALLENGE TEAMS' ROLL-OFFS
RULES, PARTICIPANT INFORMATION, and NOMINATION FORM

ELIGIBILITY

Nomination is open to all bowlers meeting eligibility criteria;

- 1) For both tournaments:
 - a. Be resident in the Zone for which the roll-off is being held
 - b. Have attained, or will attain, the age of 18 years on, or prior to, the first day of the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival in the current year
 - c. Have competed in at least eight (8) weeks of league competition, bowling a minimum of twenty-four (24) games in a league in a registered Centre, within the Zone for which the roll-off is being held
- 2) For the **Restricted** tournament:
 - a. Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 184
 - b. Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 174
- 3) For the **Classic** tournament:
 - a. Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 199
 - b. Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 189

AVERAGE

The average to be used for the roll-off must be over a minimum of eighteen (18) games, and must be the highest of the following when measured at the **end of the previous year**;

- 1) Regular league average
- 2) ATBSO average
- 3) Touring league average

HANDICAP

Handicap will be applicable to bowler's scores when used towards the **Restricted** team, and shall be **100%** of the difference between the bowler's average and a threshold of **200**

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Smoking, and the Consumption of Alcohol, is prohibited during a session of continuous games.

DISPUTES

Any disputes or complaints must be lodged with the Tournament Director within fifteen minutes of the alleged infringement.

BOWLING ATTIRE

All bowlers are required to wear a Shirt with a collar. Neat and tidy bowling attire with no jeans or hats to be worn whilst competing without the approval of the Tournament Director. The Tournament Committee to decide on acceptable attire.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) All TBA Tournament Rules & Regulations will apply
- 2) Any matters not covered in the conditions will be decided by the Tournament Committee
- 3) No refunds will be paid
- 4) Participation in your State Championships will not be a requirement
- 5) If a Team Vacancy arises the spot will be filled by the next available bowler who participated in the roll-offs
- 6) Depending on the outcome of Fundraising Events throughout the year, individual bowlers will be required to pay all expenses remaining.
- 7) Cost of Roll-offs is to be paid at Check In before commencement of Day 1.
- 8) Cost of Roll-Off is \$ 107.00

COSTS AND DEPOSITS

The following information is applicable to either team, and in the case where a bowler makes both teams the following should be applied for both teams (in effect, the amounts are double for bowlers in both teams), so that both teams may offset their preliminary costs

Costs for Challenge Teams include Accommodation, Lunches for the days of the Challenge, All Events Entries, 2 Shirts, Lineage, Dinner Tickets, and the Tournament Registration Fee. The costs must be paid as per the following payment schedule;

1. \$100.00 deposit, within 14 days of the conclusion of the roll-offs [by the 14th March 2010]
 - a. \$250.00 second part, on or before **7th May 2010** This payment is required for all bowlers and team officials, irrespective of any fundraising that may have been participated in
2. \$250.00 third part, on or before **18th June 2010**
 - a. This payment is required for all bowlers and team officials, irrespective of any fundraising that may have been participated in
3. A final payment of \$300.00 on or before **6th August 2010**
 - a. This payment will depend on fundraising

If the final payment of the full balance cannot be met by the due date, the person involved will be deemed ineligible to participate in the Holt Challenge for the current year and will be replaced by the next available bowler.....

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Every bowler who wishes to Roll-Off for the NSW Holt Teams will have to be a Financial Member. The membership fee for 2010 will be **\$ 7.00** and will be included in the cost of the 2010 Holt NSW Roll-Offs.

COMPULSORY TOURNAMENT

In 2010 Holt NSW will be holding the 2nd John Laver Scotch Doubles Tournament. We will be using this Tournament as a Fundraiser and an Introduction for new Bowlers into Holt.

Date will be 11th July 2010 at AMF Castle Hill. Cost to be advised.

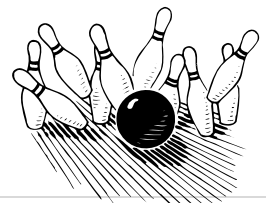
COMPULSORY PRACTICE SESSIONS
