2024 NQ HOLT CHALLENGE TEAM ROLL-OFFS

ELIGIBILITY

Nomination is open to all bowlers meeting eligibility criteria:

1) For **<u>BOTH</u>** tournaments:

a. Be a resident in the Zone for which the roll-off is being held

b. Have attained, or will attain, the age of 18 years on, or prior to, the first day of the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival in the current year

c. Have competed in at least eight (8) weeks of league competition, bowling a minimum of twenty four (24) games in a single league within the Zone for which the roll-off is being held

d. Must be a TBA registered bowler

- 2) For the **<u>Restricted</u>** tournament:
- a. Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 184
- b. Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 174
- 3) For the **Classic** tournament:
- a. Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 199
- b. Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 189

MEMBERSHIP FEES

Every bowler who wishes to Roll-off for the NQ Holt Teams will be required to be a Financial Member. The Membership fee for 2024 is \$15 and will be included in the cost of the 2024 NQ Roll-offs

AVERAGE

Taken from Bowling information as at 31st December 2023

Please list all leagues during 2023. This includes ALL leagues, touring leagues and leagues finishing midyear, end of year or any unfinished league with 24 games or more bowled.

HANDICAP

Handicap will be applicable to bowlers scores when used towards the <u>Restricted</u> team, and shall be <u>100%</u> of the difference between the bowlers average and a threshold of <u>200</u>.

SMOKING and CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Smoking, and the Consumption of Alcohol is prohibited from the first practice ball bowled until the last competition ball is bowled on each day.

DISPUTES

Any disputes or complaints must be lodged with the Tournament Director within fifteen minutes of the alleged infringement.

BOWLING ATTIRE

All bowlers are required to wear a bowling shirt, with or without a collar or a plain polo shirt. Tailored pants/knee length shorts/skirts or ³/₄ pants. Bowlers must present themselves in neat and tidy bowling attire with no jeans/jean shorts, football shorts, stubble shorts and no hats to be worn whilst competing without the approval of the Tournament Director.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) All TBA Tournament Rules & Regulations will apply
- 2) Any Holt Challenge specific rules apply (Can be found on www.holtchallenge.org.au)
- 3) Any matters not covered in the conditions will be decided by the Tournament Committee
- 4) If a Team vacancy arises, the spot will be filled by the next available bowler who participated in the roll-offs
- 5) Depending on the outcome of fundraising events throughout the year, individual bowlers will be required to pay all expenses remaining

SCHEDULE

DAY 1 - 7 GAMES

Townville Tenpin – Saturday 16th March, 2024

Check In Closes 12:30 PM for 1.00 PM Start. Failure to check-in by the required time on the first day of the trials will result in automatic disqualification. A briefing will occur prior to the commencement of play

DAY 2 - 7 GAMES Townsville Tenpin – Sunday 17th March, 2024

Check In Closes 08:30 AM for 09:00 AM Start. Late arrivals on the second day will be permitted to bowl, but the score will be zero for all frames missed. Any games affected by missed frames will not be counted toward the 'Trials average' used at the Carnival

SELECTION OF TEAMS

At the completion of the 14 games and ALL scores are checked, the Tournament Committee will announce the teams for both the Restricted and Classic Challenges, based upon the following;

1) HOLT RESTRICTED CHALLENGE TEAM (Male Team and Female Team)

The top seven (7) male, and top seven (7) female bowlers based on total score with handicap will be declared the Holt Restricted Challenge Team for the current year

a. In the event of a tie for either the final position or the first position in either division, a one game playoff will be conducted with the winner taking the higher position

b. Handicap shall be applied as normal to the playoff game.

2) HOLT CLASSIC CHALLENGE TEAM (Mixed Team)

The top four (4) male, and top three (3) female bowlers based on total scratch score only will be declared the Holt Classic Challenge Team for the current year

a. In the event of a tie for either the final position or the first position in either division, a one game playoff will be conducted with the winner taking the higher position

REPRESENTATION at TROPHY EVENTS (Masters)

The top qualifier in male Classic and Restricted, and female Classic and Restricted will earn the right to represent the zone at the relevant trophy event during the current years Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival. Each qualifying representative will receive a Masters Shirt and their Masters Entry Fee will be paid for.

ROLL OFF PRIZES

There will be prizes for High Game Male, High Game Female, High Game with Handicap Male, High Game with Handicap Female. The value of these prizes will be cash (\$100 per prize guaranteed). There may be novelty prizes that will be awarded, but not actually part of the official roll off. This will be dependent on prizes donated by local businesses.

For those who were unsuccessful in their roll off attempt, please fill out the draft forms and return to Janet. We will still need bowlers for the national Fusion Teams, and State Teams who are short of team members. You will be placed in the draft, and if you wish to bowl – you may be contacted after all states have rolled off, and we start the draft selection for each state requiring bowlers, then the formation of the Fusion Teams.

*Please Note: A form will be given to everyone at the Roll Off. For those who are successful in a representative spot in a team (and supporters and/or open bowlers), to confirm your place on the team, please complete the forms and return to Kimberley Carney on HoltNQTD@outlook.com with your Commitment Deposit of **\$200** per bowler by 29th March, 2024. You will then be sent an invoice with the estimated costs for the events you are selected for, shirts, lineage, and if required, accommodation, local transport/hire vehicles, etc. You will be responsible for your own transport to Tasmania and home. The invoice will have a payment schedule, which will have a fortnightly recommended amount to pay to help you with your budget. This allows the committee to meet the financial commitments and payment deadlines of the tournament events, and the arrangements made on behalf of the teams by the committee.
