## ELIGIBILITY

Nomination is open to all bowlers meeting eligibility criteria.

- 1) For both tournaments:
  - a) Be resident in the Zone for which the roll-off is being held at
  - b) Have attained, or will attain, the age of 18 years on, or prior to, the first day of the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival in that current year
  - c) Have competed in a minimum of twenty-four (24) games in a single league in a registered Centre within the Zone for which the trials are being held.
  - d) Be a registered TBA member
- 2) For the **Restricted** tournament:
  - a) Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 184
  - b) Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 174
- 3) For the **Classic** tournament:
  - a) Male bowlers must not have an average exceeding 199
  - b) Female bowlers must not have an average exceeding 189

## AVERAGES

### Taken from Bowling information as at 31 December 2023

Please list all leagues during 2023. This includes ALL leagues, touring leagues and leagues finishing midyear, ending of the year or any unfinished league with 24 games or more bowled.

**\*\*\* The Tournament Director will be confirming averages and may regrade at their discretion. \*\*\***

## HANDICAP

Handicap will be applicable to bowlers' scores when used towards the **Restricted** team and shall be **100%** of the difference between the bowler's average and a maximum threshold of **200**.

## SMOKING and CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Smoking and the Consumption of Alcohol is prohibited whilst the roll-offs are in progress and until the last ball is bowled on each day.

## DISPUTES

Any disputes or complaints must be lodged with the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the alleged infringement.

## BOWLING ATTIRE

All bowlers are required to wear a collared shirt and tailored pants/shorts/skirts. Neat and tidy bowling attire, with no jeans or hats are to be worn whilst competing, without the approval of the Tournament Director.

The Tournament Committee will decide on acceptable attire.

## GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

- 1) All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply.
- 2) Any matters not covered in the conditions will be decided by the Tournament Committee.
- 3) No refunds will be paid.
- 4) Participation in your State Championships is not a requirement.
- 5) If a Team Vacancy arises, the spot will be filled by the next available bowler who participated in the roll-offs.
- 6) Depending on the outcome of Fundraising Events throughout the year, individual bowlers will be required to pay all expenses remaining.
- 7) Any Outstanding Costs of the Trials are to be paid at the time of check in on Day 1.

## COVID-19

Any requirements pertaining to COVID-19 for the roll offs and National Tournament will be communicated to all bowlers as and when they come into force

## SCHEDULE

A briefing will occur before commencement of play on the first day.

DAY 1, 7 GAMES      DATE: Saturday 2nd March 2024 CHECK-IN CLOSES: 12.30 pm for 1.00 pm start  
Late check-in will not be accepted without prior notice to the Tournament Director.

DAY 2, 7 GAMES      DATE: Sunday 3rd March 2024 CHECK-IN CLOSES: 08.30 am for 09.00 am start

Late arrivals on the second day will be permitted to bowl, but the score will be zero for all frames missed. Any games affected by missed frames will not be counted toward the 'Trials average' used at the Carnival

## **SELECTION OF TEAMS**

At the completion of the 14 games, the tournament director will announce the teams for both the Restricted and Classic Challenges, based upon the following:

### **HOLT RESTRICTED CHALLENGE TEAMS:**

- 1) The top seven (7) male and top seven (7) female bowlers based on total score with handicap will be declared the Holt Restricted Challenge Team for the current year.
  - a) In the event of a tie for the either first & second or the final position in either division, a one game roll off will be used to determine the final place.
  - b) Handicap shall be applied as normal to the playoff game.

### **HOLT CLASSIC COMBINED CHALLENGE TEAM:**

- 2) The top four (4) male and top three (3) female bowlers based on total scratch score only will be declared the Holt Classic Challenge Team for the current year.
  - a) In the event of a tie for the either first & second or the final position in either division, a one game playoff will be used to determine the final place.

## **REPRESENTATION at TROPHY EVENTS**

The top Male and Female qualifier in the respective teams will earn the right to represent the Zone at the relevant trophy event during the current year's Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival.

## **THE HOLT TENPIN BOWLING CARNIVAL**

The 2024 Holt Challenge Teams will compete in the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival to be conducted at Zone Bowling Moonah, Sunday 11th – Friday 23rd August 2024.

All bowlers who are not successful in making the teams are welcome to attend the Holt Tenpin Bowling Carnival to participate in the other events and apply to be part of the national draft. Further information can be found at [www.holtchallenge.org.au](http://www.holtchallenge.org.au).

## **MEMBERSHIP FEES**

Every bowler who wishes to Roll-off for the SQ Holt Teams will be required to be a Financial Member. The Membership fee for 2024 will be \$20 and is included in the cost of the 2024 SQ Roll-offs.

## **COSTS AND DEPOSITS**

The following information is applicable to either team, and in the case where a bowler makes both teams, additional funds will be applied to each payment, so that both teams may offset their preliminary costs.

Costs for Challenge Teams includes accommodation, travel between accommodation and bowl, lunches and snacks on days of challenge, All Events entries, uniform shirts, dinner dance tickets, and the tournament registration fee. The costs must be paid as per the following payment schedule:

- 1) \$100.00 deposit, at the conclusion of the roll-offs on Sunday 3rd March 2024 before you leave the Bowling Centre**
- 2) \$150.00 second part, on or before 15th March 2024
- 3) \$300.00 third part, on or before 15th April 2024
- 4) \$300.00 fourth part, on or before 15th May 2024
- 5) \$300.00 fifth part, on or before 15th June 2024
- 6) \$300.00 sixth part, on or before 15th July 2024
- 7) A final payment, on or before 1<sup>st</sup> August 2024
- 8) This payment will depend on fundraising
- 9) If the final payment of the full balance cannot be met by the due date, the person involved will be deemed ineligible to participate in the Holt Challenge for the current year

### **NOTE:**

- 1) **Failure to make any payment in the outlined schedule without sufficient prior notice to the Committee will deem the person ineligible to participate in the Holt Challenge for the current year**
- 2) Bowlers who make both teams will be required to pay an additional \$100 at the conclusion of the roll offs and an additional \$100 with each subsequent scheduled payment.
- 3) Managers who are successful in their application will be required to pay \$100 deposit on acceptance of their position.
- 4) Balance of fees may be made at any time in line with the above schedule.

These costs are based on previous year's expenses. Further details will be provided in a welcome pack upon being named in the Classic and/or Restricted teams.

- Bowlers record sheet(s) from the previous year
- **A \$100 deposit for making the team is payable on the final day before leaving the centre.**
